July the 14. 1864

Dear friend we received  
your letter the 9 of July  
and it founds all as well  
as common and I was glad  
to hear from you & gain  
me an all at this and hope  
that this will find you all  
well I cant give you any  
true statement about V D  
I cant get any news  
correct from there there  
is troops at Fayetteville but  
General Crooks is making raids  
all this spring and summer he  
went to newbourn and whip the  
rails and tore up the rail road and  
burnt the bridge and then went to  
harrisburg and to Stanton and  
to Lynchburg and down all he  
wanted to do and now is gone  
to pencyvania

I can't get a letter to  
 father any more I don't  
 know what is <sup>the</sup> reason I am  
 trying to find out and to  
 get all the news I can and  
 when I can find out I will let  
 you know I can tell you  
 that the yankees has got  
 Bill Thompson in Jun they  
 got him on Suel Mountain  
 they had not killed him  
 yet but I think they will  
 times is tolerable good here  
 wheat crops is short corn  
 is tolerable good corn is 100<sup>B</sup> per  
 bush wheat is 20<sup>B</sup> per bush I think I made  
~~100~~ one hundred B of wheat my  
 corn is good it is over my  
 head as I plow some is sicking  
 my oats is good and all most  
 ripe I have got up on half  
 stack and has 5 ackers yet  
 to cut I cut on the halves

I have nothing much write at  
 this time and it is time I was  
 gone to church I am going to  
 hear a woman preach today  
 I would be glad to see you all  
 get wife and children and  
 love and all of our old friends  
 we would be glad to see  
 them come this fall and  
 we will go to a visit soon  
 so nothing more at present  
 but your true friend
