and volunteered in the union
army John Sanna and
E. M. Key is at home in peace

I saiah Smith and Elizabeth
is at Coneston and jest be
low "D J" Cadde came
to camp piat in march
and took the person and
died and left his family
in ~~very~~ *very* *very* *very* *very*
Benjamin Gayland is at Mill
Thomas is in Thormore corn
Tom bogas snore a tie a
ginst hiram Sannaw and
they sent him to camp chad
and he did than Thormore
has stole the last horse
father shad if I had him I
could cut his throat
James arthur and Thomas
Smith was to see me last
week arthur lives about
twelve miles below me
General Crook went from
Fayette to Newbarn and
burnt it up and new river

Bridge and turn up the road
road for 12 miles and went to
meadow bluff and from
than to Stanton he is kill
ing all the bushwhackers
William and John White
is with him we got a letter
from them yesterday he had
forty thousand men with him
what crops is bad here my wheat
is tolerable good I have 18 acres
and 18 acres in corn it is prom
anple to grow high I have
most of it work out the first
time I have 5 acres in oats and
the finest man and coat in
gotta gallia *co Ohio* it
is very cold to day and
windy labor when I get
to thinking about old times
I cant keep my mind to
gether to write and I wish
to I wont you to write
