Mr. Saban Quinn & Brother
I seat my self this morning
to let you know that we are
all well and has bin since
we left Indiana - should these
few lines reach you I hope
they will find you and family
enjoying the same blessing

well sir I will
now try to give you a history
of our trip you know we left
Kokomo about the 31st I took
a ticket to Cincinnati which
would have cost us about 20
dollars but in reaching Rich-
mond we found the Railroad
Bridg is washed away we there
lay over 8 days than finding
we could not get on for
several days we changed

bars and took the Road by the way of Genia Hamilton
and Morrow town and landed at the Miami Expo on Satur-
day morning, we then took a Boat and started up the River
at Eleven o'clock and landed in Chambers Bay at Sunday
night at Eleven to cost for my self and 7 children \$2.90 its
my boxes has come safe they cost me 9.30
my Boys landed here day before yesterday their cost 21.00
whole cost 113.10

\$113.10 was a heavy cost but then I do not begrudge that
amount on ten times as much to get out of that blue mud hole
Indiana for it is not fit for any man to live in
we are staying with James Arthur but we expect to get in
a house of our own in a few days we have rented as much
corn ground as we can manage we pay one third of the corn
Mr. Arthur's family is all well except himself he has bin
very poorly for a few days but is ~~still~~ getting better
with it Mr. Arthur and family sends there love and Respe
to you and family I have had a notion of going home since
Richmond has bin taken but whether I go or not I will
say Amen to the fall of that Rebel Hole the Report
is that Lee and his army is captured also Jeff and his
cabinet so amen again
